## Fundamental Logistics Management (NQF Level 5)

This programme will also benefit the individual who requires knowledge of the logistics discipline and its interrelationships with other business functions within and across an organisation.

### What can students expect?

- Understanding the importance and path of a customer order
- Designing, selecting and managing a distribution channel
- Applying the principles of logistics management
- Understanding what role transportation plays in a supply chain
- Implement an evaluation of the logistics performance of an organisation and recommend improvements
